ORDER WITHDRAWING EMERGENCY ORDER OF SUSPENSION

Comes now the Commonwealth of Kentucky, by and through the Commissioner of the Department of Financial Institutions (“DFI”) and hereby enters this ORDER withdrawing a previously entered Emergency Order of Suspension entered May 7, 2026, against American First Funding, LLC formerly known as Lakeview Lending, LLC (“Respondent”).

PARTIES

1. DFI is responsible for regulating and licensing mortgage loan companies in accordance with the provisions of KRS Chapter 286.8.
2. Respondent is licensed as a mortgage company in the Commonwealth of Kentucky with a principal office address of 25925 Telegraph Road, Suite 300, Southfield, MI 48033. The registered agent address on file in Kentucky is Incorp Services, Inc. at 828 Lane Allen Road Suite 219, Lexington, Kentucky 40504. Respondent’s Kentucky license number is MC867638. Respondent’s NMLS number is 2362008.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

3. On May 7, 2026, the commissioner entered an Emergency Order to suspend the mortgage company license of Respondent.
4. The Emergency Order was entered after a finding that there were grounds satisfactory to the commissioner that the mortgage loan company had engaged or was engaging in unsafe, unsound, and/or illegal practices that posed an imminent threat to the public interest.
5. The commissioner is now satisfied that there is not an ongoing *imminent* threat to the public interest.
6. The commissioner is not waiving any claim for violations of applicable regulations or statutes, only stating that there does not appear to be an *imminent* threat such that the continuation of an Emergency Order of Suspension is merited at this time.

### STATUTORY AUTHORITY FOR THIS ACTION

7. The commissioner may withdraw an emergency order or enter a subsequent order superseding an emergency order per KRS 286.8-048(6) which states:

An emergency order issued under this section shall remain in effect until it is withdrawn or superseded by an order of the commissioner or until it is terminated by a court order.

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

8. Respondent is not presently engaged in unsafe, unsound, and illegal practices that pose an *imminent* threat to the public interest.

### ORDER

9. The prior Emergency Order of May 7, 2026, suspending the license of American First Funding, LLC, formerly known as Lakeview Lending, LLC is hereby withdrawn. This Order supersedes any previous order of the commissioner concerning American First Funding, LLC,

formerly known as Lakeview Lending, LLC, in regard to the subject matter of the May 7, 2026,  
Emergency Order.
