

FINAL AGREED ORDER

- 1. The Department of Financial Institutions ("DFI") is responsible for regulating and licensing mortgage loan brokers, mortgage loan companies, mortgage loan originators, and mortgage loan processors in accordance with the provisions set forth in KRS Chapter 286.8, the Mortgage Loan Company and Mortgage Loan Broker Act (the "Act").
- 2. First Residential Mortgage Network, Inc. ("First Residential") is authorized to do business in Kentucky as a licensed mortgage loan company (MC 17857) pursuant to the Act, with its principal office located at 9721 Ormsby Station Road, Suite 105, Louisville, KY 40223.

- 3. Jeremy Branum ("Branum") is an individual employed by First Residential who resides at 16813 Polo Fields Lane, Louisville, KY 40245
- 4. Ken Payton ("Payton") is an individual employed by First Residential who resides at 4408 Arroyo Trail, Louisville, KY 40229.
- 5. Nathaniel Peters ("Peters") is an individual employed by First Residential who resides at 8802 New LaGrange Road, Louisville, KY 40242.
- 6. On December 17, 2009, the DFI filed an Administrative Complaint against the Respondents alleging: (a) that First Residential violated KRS 286.8-030(1)(d) by using three unregistered mortgage loan originators; (b) that Branum violated KRS 286.8-030(1)(c) by acting as a mortgage loan originator without being registered; (c) that Payton violated KRS 286.8-030(1)(c) by acting as a mortgage loan originator without being registered and (d) that Peters violated KRS 286.8-030(1)(c) by acting as a mortgage loan originator without being registered.
- 7. On January 4, 2010, the Respondents filed a Response to the DFI's Administrative Complaint and denied the DFI's allegations regarding violations of the Act.
- 8. In the interest of economically and efficiently resolving this matter and avoid the expense, inconvenience, and uncertainty of further administrative proceedings, and without any admission of fault or wrongdoing by the Respondents, the parties agree as follows.
 - a. Branum agrees to pay a fine in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00);
 - b. Payton agrees to a pay a fine in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00);
 - c. Peters agrees to pay a fine in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00);

- d. First Residential agrees to pay a fine in the amount of seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500.00);
- e. Branum, Payton, Peters, and First Residential agree to and shall pay their respective fines assessed herein prior to the entry of this Order, which shall be in the form of a certified check or money order made payable to "Kentucky State Treasurer" and mailed to the Department of Financial Institutions, Attn: Simon Berry, 1025 Capital Center Drive, Suite 200, Frankfort, Kentucky 40601;
- f. Upon payment of the fine and the entry of this Final Agreed Order, this administrative action shall be dismissed with prejudice. The DFI shall provide a copy of this Order to the Hearing Officer.
- 9. The Respondents waive their right to demand a hearing at which they would be entitled to legal representation, to confront and cross examine witnesses, and to present evidence on their own behalf, or to otherwise appeal or set aside this Order.
- 10. The Respondents consent to and acknowledge the jurisdiction of DFI over this matter and that this Order is a matter of public record and may be disseminated as such.
- 11. In consideration of execution of this Final Agreed Order, the Respondents, for themselves, and for their successors and assigns, hereby release and forever discharge the Commonwealth of Kentucky, DFI, Office of Legal Services, and each of their members, agents, and employees in their individual capacities, from any and all manner of actions, causes of action, suits, debts, judgments, executions, claims and demands whatsoever, known and unknown, in law or equity, that the Respondents ever had, now have, may have or claim to have against any or all of the persons or entities named in this paragraph arising out of or by reason of this investigation, this disciplinary action, this settlement or its administration.

By signing below, the parties acknowledge they have read the foregoing Agreed 12. Order, know and fully understand its contents, and that they are authorized to enter into and execute this Final Agreed Order and legally bind their respective parties.
