Plaintiff requested a restraining order pending final judgment in this action, with Plaintiff alleging through verified complaint with supporting affidavits, that Defendants' unlawful offer and sale of securities through failure to make proper disclosure in connection with same and engaging in conduct that would work or tend to work a fraud on investors and/or would constitute an artifice to defraud in violation of KRS 292.320, causes and will continue to cause irreparable harm to the citizens of Kentucky and persons outside Kentucky from acts that originate in Kentucky. Plaintiff further stated that such persons are persons for whose benefit and protection the securities laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky provide. A hearing was held on the request on Friday, June 9, 2006, at approximately 11:00 a.m., with Defendant, Brian Rose and his counsel present, having arrived nearly at the beginning of the hearing and in time to make arguments and objections to the Plaintiff's request. Upon the arrival of Brian Rose and counsel, his counsel objected to the to the restraining order and hearing in part on the grounds that counsel and Brian Rose had not had an opportunity to review the Verified Complaint and the supporting affidavits. Both sides presented arguments, substantive and procedural, and the Court considered same.

This Court finds that Plaintiff is entitled to his requested Restraining Order.

THEREFORE, upon the request of Plaintiff, the Court having reviewed the Verified Complaint herein, listened to counsel for both sides, and being otherwise sufficiently advised, and for the reasons set forth above, it is hereby ORDERED that Jupiter Energy, LLC, JUPITER 2005-6, LLP, Brian Rose, personally, Jason T. Rose, personally, Thomas N. Nelson, personally, and Dawn R. Nelson, personally; and their agents, officers, members, attorneys, and any person in active concert or participation


with them, are hereby RESTRAINED and prohibited from any and all activity or conduct in or from the Commonwealth of Kentucky in the offer or sale of securities of Jupiter Energy, LLC, JUPITER 2005-6, LLP, Brian Rose, personally, and/or Jason T. Rose, personally, or any one or several of them, directly or indirectly, pending a final judgment in this action;

PROVIDED HOWEVER, Defendants shall not be restrained from making said offers and sales if and only if they disclose in writing to any and all prospective investor by addendum or other writing with said addendum or writing:

a.) including at a minimum, disclosure that certain legal and administrative matters arose and exist involving David Rose, enTerra Energy, L.L.C., and/or Enterra Energy, and expressly including the style and case number of this Court Case Number 04-CI-00895, the existence of the agreed order of injunction in that matter, and the essence of its contents; and

b.) including disclosure that the office listed in Tulsa, Oklahoma for the Defendants herein is just an answering machine or service and that operations are from the offices in Louisville, Kentucky rather than Oklahoma.

This Restraining Order is so issued at 4 o'clock, 1 m., this the 12 day of June, 2006.
