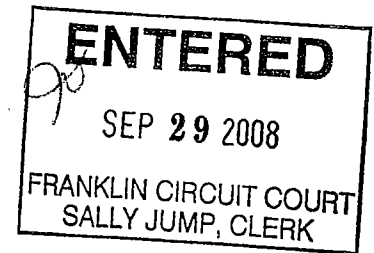

This Court having considered the testimony and evidence of both parties and being otherwise well informed on the matter hereby issues the following order:

- (1) Respondent Ernest Cadick is hereby found to be in contempt of the Order of this Court of January 14, 2008, having continually failed to make the required payments under the settlement agreement to Petitioner in a timely fashion.
- (2) Respondent Cadick shall have ninety (90) days from the issuance of this Order to purge himself of contempt by making the required five-hundred dollar (\$500) monthly payments as required under the Court's previous Order. A total of one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) SHALL be paid to the Petitioner within ninety (90) days.
- (3) This matter will be scheduled for a progress hearing on January 5, 2009 at 9:00 A.M. in the Franklin Circuit Court.
- (4) Should Petitioner fail to meet his financial obligations under the earlier Order within the ninety (90) day period, he SHALL be placed under arrest for contempt to serve a period of ninety (90) days of confinement for violation of the Court's Order.

- (5) Should Petitioner fail to personally appear before this Court on January 5, 2009,
a bench warrant for his arrest SHALL be issued at that time.
